CBTU-Ontario Chapter is pleased to call for applications for its annual Ann Newman Scholarship Fund. The Scholarship is awarded in honour of Ann Newman a labour and community activist and a CEP member.

Please find attached the CBTU Ann Newman Scholarship Fund Application.

This Fund was established to provide partial scholarships to members of CBTU-Ontario/Canada Chapter, their children, grandchildren primarily and then youth in the Black community pursuing a post-secondary education.

Any student who has graduated or will be graduating from a Canadian High School or an equivalent program and who will be or is attending a recognized post-secondary institution such as a college, trade school or university, and is a member, child, grandchild or family member of a CBTU member in good standing, or a youth in the Black community, is eligible to apply.

One scholarship will be awarded to the successful applicant as chosen by the Fund's Selection Committee. The scholarship will be \$1,000. In the event that two applicants are equally qualified, two scholarships will be awarded at \$500.00 each.

The Scholarship(s) will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Essay submission – 500 words.
- Topic: Why is there a need for an organization like CBTU, how will you as a recipient support the organization's mission and update the organization on all of your activities in promoting CBTU and its mission during the upcoming year?
- List your involvement in community activities including: multi-cultural, religious, athletic and any other community or union organizations.
- List paid or volunteer work experience.
- Secondary school marks and academic achievement.
- Financial need.
